PUBLIC NOTICE

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that Chapter 29, Article II of the City of Salamanca Municipal Code, sets forth the Enforcement Procedures which are initiated by the Plumbing Inspector.

Section 29.31 requires that the Plumbing inspector reports to the Examining Board of Plumbers, any person or corporation engaged in or carrying on the business of employing a master plumber without having the certificate required by Section 29.24.

The report should be made to the Board in writing setting forth the facts and circumstance of the situation as found by the Inspector.

Since the individual in violation is not registered, the Code does not require that written notice of the violation be given to the individual, although there is no prohibition against such notice being given by the Inspector.

Upon the report of the Inspector, the Examining Board of Plumbers may proceed to authorize the prosecution of the individual pursuant to the provisions of the Code which would result in the Plumbing Inspector filing an information with the Salamanca City Court followed by the issuance of an appearance ticket. Penalties include a fine of up to \$250.00 per occurrence or fifteen (15) days in jail, or both. The individual may also be denied a certificate of competency or registration as a Master Plumber.

The City of Salamanca Municipal Code provides that any person, firm or corporation performing plumbing work in the City must be registered and have or be a licensed master plumber, or be a resident homeowner where the work is being performed.

In the event the Plumbing Inspector determines that the plumbing work is being performed in the City by a person not a registered licensed master plumber or resident homeowner, violators will be prosecuted under the Code provision.
