

“The offender registry includes only those persons who have been required by law to register and who are in compliance with the offender registration laws. The information is provided as a public service and may not be current or accurate. Persons should not rely solely on the offender registry as a safeguard against offenses in their communities. The crime for which a person is convicted may not accurately reflect the level of risk. Anyone who uses information contained in the registry to harass registrants or commit any crime may be subject to criminal prosecution.”
